



World Heritage Site

Bamberg is a work of art, boasting one of the largest intact Old Towns in Europe. Built on an early mediaeval footprint, the city has a fascinating and overwhelming abundance of original buildings – dating from the Middle Ages to the Baroque period. The area of the World Heritage Site covers three historical centres.

The unique MARKET GARDENERS' DISTRICT

The district has a living tradition of market gardening and wine growing. Urban market gardening has continued here without interruption since the Middle Ages!

Bergstadt (City on the hills)



The episcopal CITY ON THE HILLS

Built on seven hills, it is characterised by imposing architecture, including the towering Imperial Cathedral on Cathedral Hill and other impressive monuments.



The civic ISLAND CITY

This is the vibrant home of the trades and of retail. Its landmark, the Old Town Hall, is built in the middle of the river.
