



Terms of use E-bike battery charging cabinet at Tourist Information

§ 1 Subject matter of the contract

(1) The City of Bamberg / BAMBERG Tourismus & Kongress Service (TKS) provides visitors with these chargeable lockers exclusively for temporary use as charging stations for their e-bike batteries under the following conditions.

(2) The placing of other items, in particular valuables, keys and similar items for opening locking devices, perishable and malodorous items, live animals or items that fall under weapons or dangerous goods regulations is prohibited in these lockers.

(3) Notwithstanding the foregoing, users are advised in their own interest not to store items of personal (material or non-material) value (e.g. personal photos, cell phones and other electronic devices, mementos of close relatives, diaries) in the lockers.

§ 2 Period of Storage and End of Use

(1) Permitted items pursuant to § 1 item 2 may be stored in the lockers for up to 24 hours.

(2) Use of the locker begins when the locker is properly locked after a €2 deposit has been entered into the locker. The locker can be locked and opened only once per entry of the €2 usage fee. The red return button is only used to return the usage fee before the locker has been locked for the first time.

(3) Use ends when the locker is opened. At the end of use, the user must empty the locker completely, remove any dirt caused by usage and close the door.

§ 3 Usage fee

(1) For each use, a fee of one 2-euro coin is to be paid into the cash box provided for this purpose in the locking system.

(2) The storage of objects for longer than 24 hours is prohibited, also in the interest of other users.

§ 4 Violation of the Terms and Conditions of Use, in particular exceeding the permissible storage period

(1) In case of exceeding the permissible storage period (§ 2 Para. 1), insufficient clearing of the locker (§ 2 Para. 3) or if there is suspicion that prohibited items (§ 1 Para. 2) are in the locker, TKS shall be entitled to open the locker and to take possession of the deposited items.

(2) The items taken into possession will be stored at a charge of 2 € per day and can be collected from the Tourist Information within 10 days upon payment of the storage fee, starting on the day on which the storage period was exceeded. The TKS is not or no longer obliged to provide safekeeping as soon as the safekeeping fee or the safekeeping expense exceeds the estimated material value of the items.

(3) After expiration of the safekeeping period pursuant to the provisions of paragraph 2, the items shall become the property of TKS and may be disposed of without compensation or at the customer's expense, unless TKS makes use of its option to forward the items to the lost and found office of the City of Bamberg. In this case, no finder's fee shall be claimed. The obligation to pay the custody fee pursuant to § 4 (2) for the period of safekeeping at the TKS shall remain unaffected.

§ 5 Loss of keys

If the user of the locker loses the key provided to him for temporary use (e.g. theft or loss) or if the maximum permissible usage period is exceeded, the locking device on the locker can be replaced. If the key is not returned within 10 days, beginning with the day on which the locker was left for longer than the maximum time allowed, the user may be charged a fee of €45 for the replacement of the locking device, regardless of fault.

Any liability for inadmissibly deposited items within the meaning of § 1 paragraph 2 is excluded. In all other respects, TKS shall only be liable for damage caused by gross negligence or intent on the part of its employees and agents; in the case of personal injury, TKS shall also be liable in the event of (simple) negligence on the part of the aforementioned persons.
